**Eligibility**

- Accepted to or attending a 2-year community college or 4-year college-level program with an emphasis in the performing arts, including but not limited to: acting, arts education, dance, music, performance, theatre arts, design/technology, writing/editing.
- Students with relatives on the WCT board may apply. The relative will not participate in any way to choose the scholarship recipient.
- An individual student may receive a maximum of three annual and separate scholarships from the WCT.

**Students must -**

- Have participated in at least one Weston Community Theatre production (cast or crew)
- Establish an ongoing interest in the performing arts with extracurricular activities and classes
- Demonstrate willingness to mentor other members of cast and crew
- Show outstanding teamwork skills within a theater production
- Exhibit leadership and teamwork abilities outside the theater through extracurricular activities or volunteer work
- Agree that, with the submission of this form, you give permission to the committee to contact any teachers, directors, mentors, etc. for references.
